

## Daphile User Manual Notes

### Audio Player

- To play a whole album, press the Play arrow at the album level
- To play one song, press the Play arrow at the song level
- [How do you move to another song once in the album and keep playing it?]
- [How do Playlists and Favorites work?]

### CD Ripper

- To rip a CD, you must set the “Target disk” to the CD or DVD drive of the music server computer.

### File Manager

- Files imported into Daphile may not show up properly in the Audio Player. Daphile uses a specific “metadata” format to label music tracks for artist, album, and song. [more needed here]•

### Settings

#### Audio Devices

- If you have an external D/A converter, Daphile will automatically recognize it and use the correct drivers.
- For the internal or external audio converter, you can set the “Volume control” to the following settings:
  - Off – BitPerfect playback
  - On – Initialize to a previous value
  - On – Initialize to a fixed value
- If your amplifier does not have a volume control, set the Volume control to “On” so that you may control the playback volume.
- When in the “Audio Player,” a volume control slider will appear on the upper right of the Daphile window.
