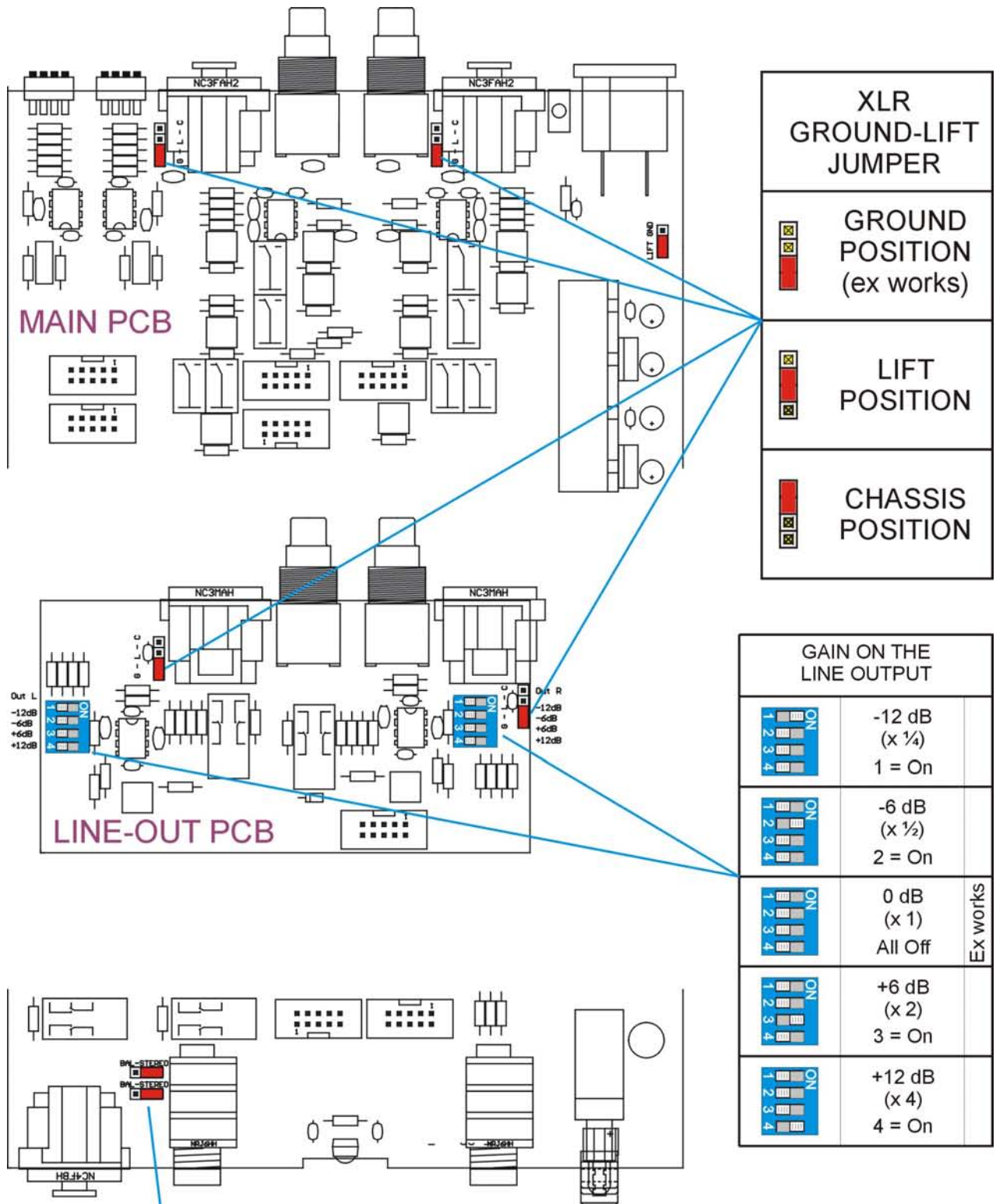

can be set by means of internal DIP switches located on the line-out circuit board. See page 33 for further details.

Generally, the level at the unbalanced output will equal the input level in pre-fader mode, or with the level control set fully clockwise in post-fader mode. By means of the DIP switches however, relative attenuation/gain can be set to -12 , -6 , 0 , $+6$ or $+12$ dB. Please note that output level at the balanced output is generally $+6$ dB higher than at the unbalanced output.
